Most often, speech therapists try to adjust speech sound disorders by drill-and-practice, when there are larger underlying oral development issues. When this is the case, students may be in speech therapy for much longer than actually needed. I am requesting a grant to assist in the payment of a virtual conference that would essentially change my entire approach to speech and language disorders. The field of speech-language pathology has a growing area of research and practice called orofacial myology. Having more expertise in orofacial myology will allow me to apply evidence-based strategies to speech problems at their root. If I am better able to treat the root of the speech disorder, students will have better outcomes in their academic skills (literacy, spelling, and overall communication) and spend less time in pull-out speech services.
